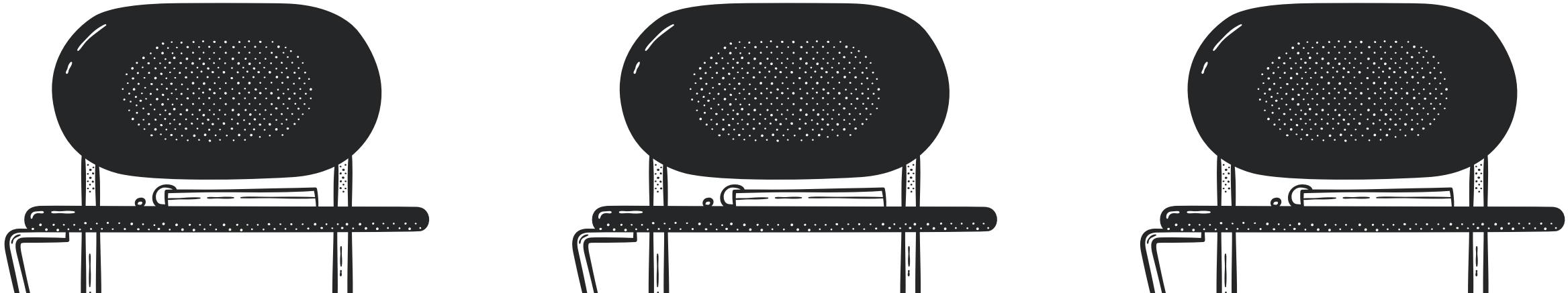
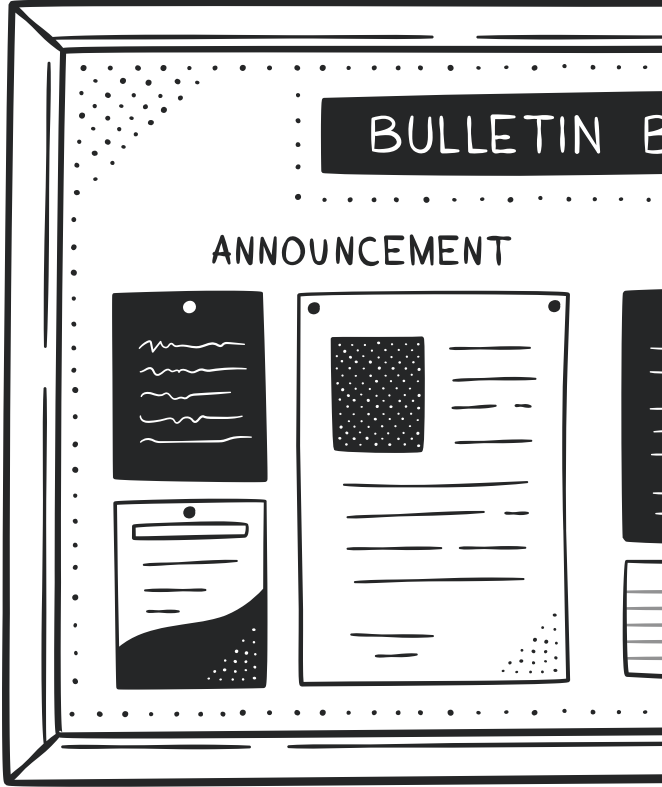

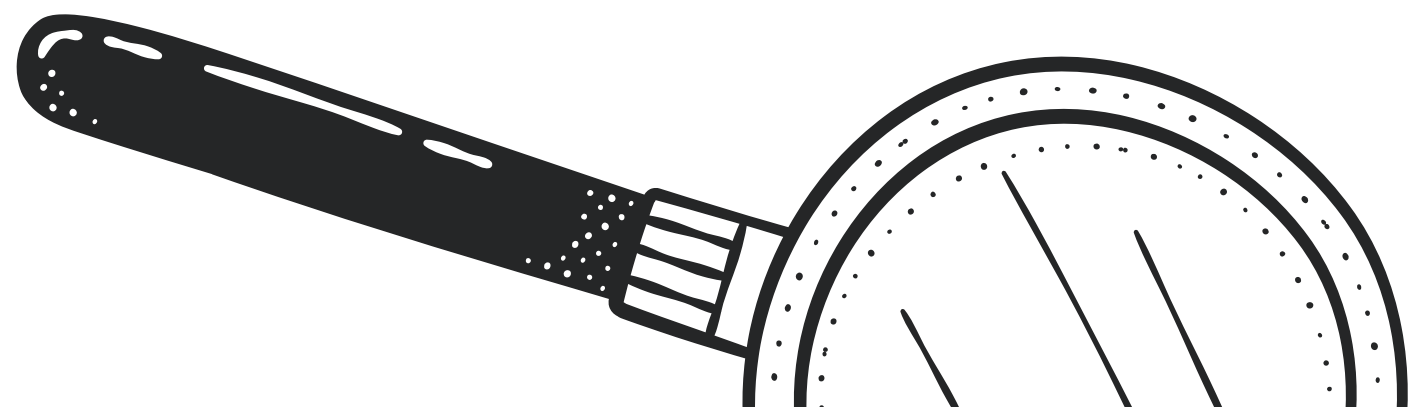

Before You Start

- Read the **green** paper first - it gives an overview of each application in the packet
- Circle the awards for which you think you might qualify
- Go to the application for the award (each is a different color) and read the detailed requirements
- The Diploma of Merit application takes the most work; the key thing to remember is you turn in only the **BLUE** paper for it when you're done

Diploma of Merit Application/ Area of Merit Form

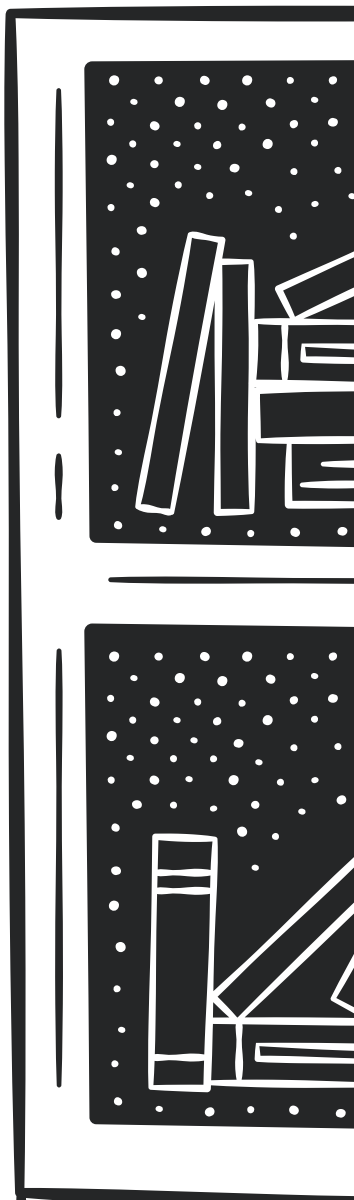
*Application **blue**; forms are white.

- Read the requirements
- Check your PTG to see if you qualify
- Fill out the white form for each area of merit
- Take it to the teacher listed on the **blue** application; they sign the **blue** application-
turn in the **blue** application when you've
gotten all your signatures

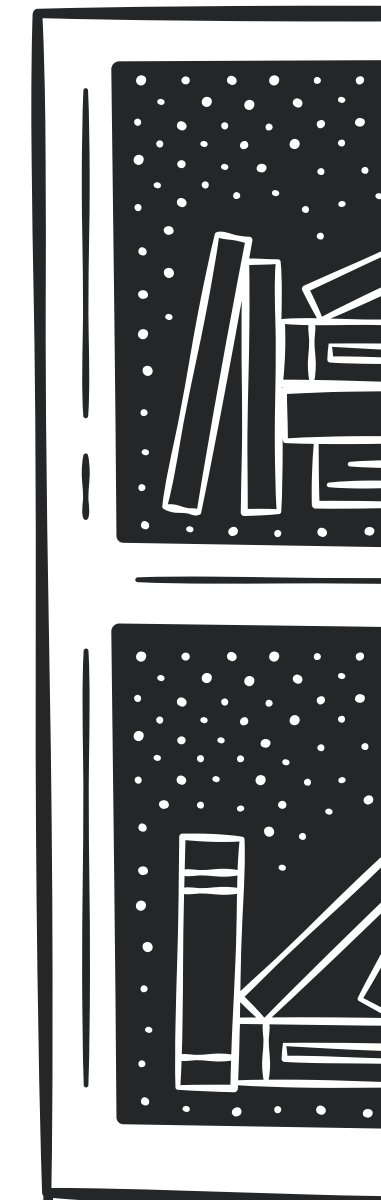
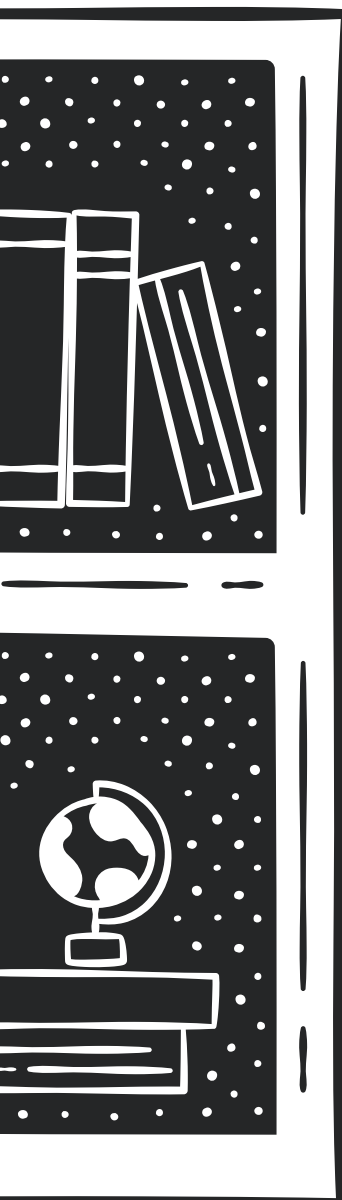
* **Pink** paper - complete this yourself;
your counselor will check it

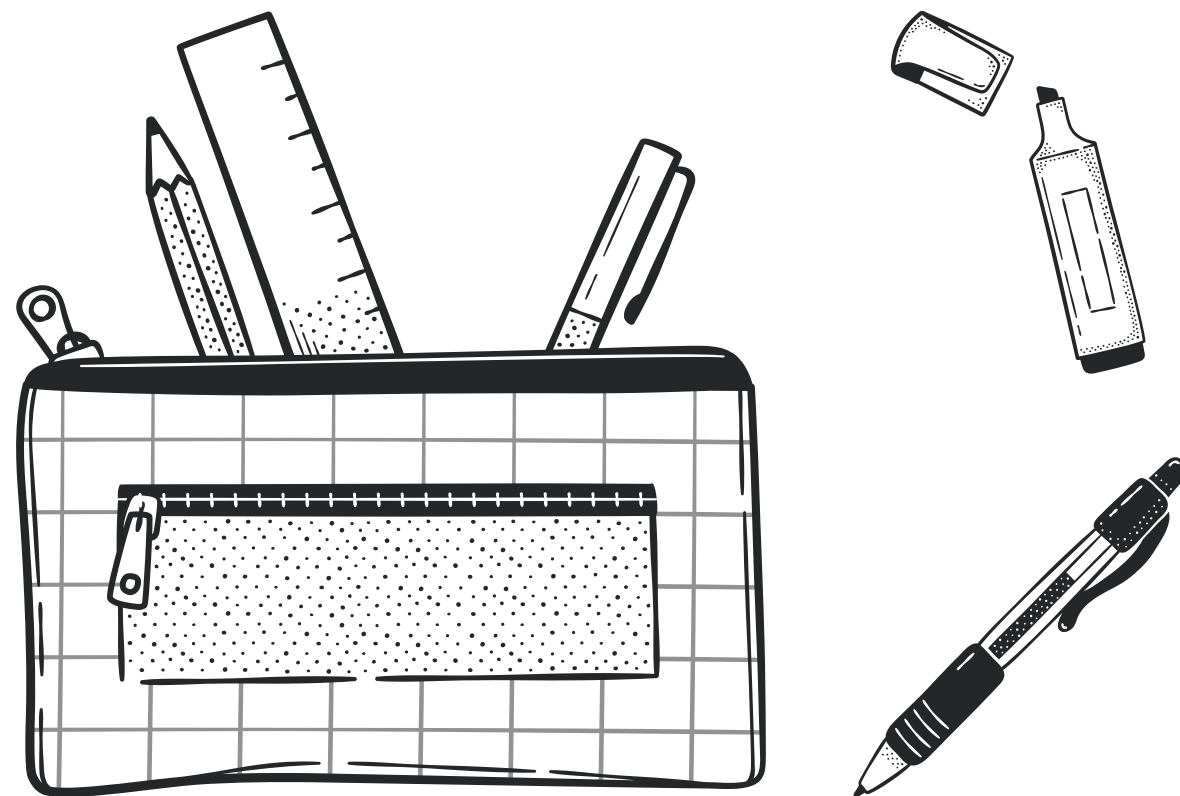
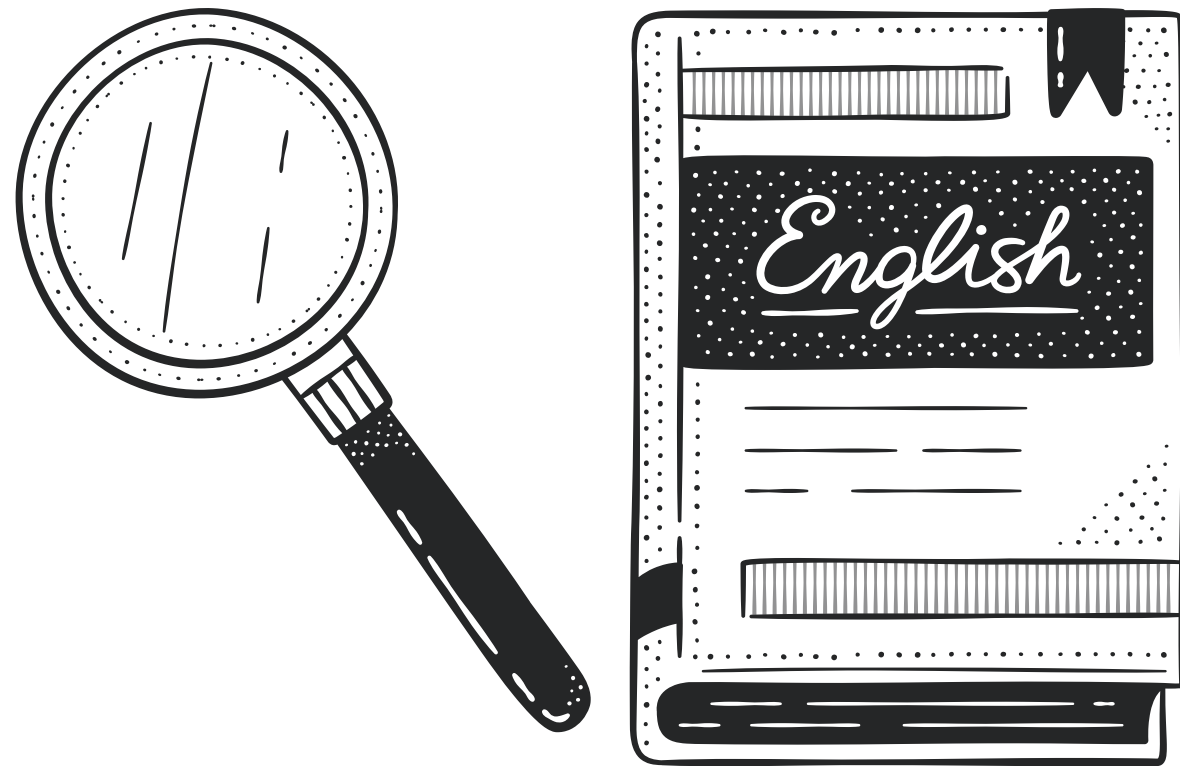
- Fill out the top section

All the achievements listed on this application will be recognized and printed on a certificate for you. *These alone are not qualifying achievements for Senior Awards Recognition

Scholarship Reporting Form

This **orange** form is where you list any scholarships you've been offered, even if you aren't accepting them. You have to show proof with an email or letter and have the college adviser sign off on the form

- The due date is **MARCH 29th** by end of day - turn in to the counseling center
